

TFL ANNUAL PROGRAMMES

FeatureLab

When a film gets more and more real. This is the programme for creative teams working on the director's 1st or 2nd feature film projects, at an advanced development stage. By joining you will have the chance to work with experts from the fields of directing, cinematography, sound, post-production, but also from production, financing, marketing & sales, and audience engagement. A big plus: FeatureLab projects will have the chance to compete for the TFL Production Awards and partners' prizes supporting the production process.

CALL OPEN UNTIL 11TH DECEMBER 2023

ScriptLab

The flagship TFL scriptwriting programme open to both emerging talents and experienced filmmakers that, guided by tutors, turn the projects into a first or second draft of the script sharing the creative process with fellow filmmakers. Each group is paired with a **Story Editor trainee** that will work in close collaboration with the filmmakers to help them find the core of their story.

THE CALLS FOR APPLICATION OPEN IN AUTUMN 2024

SeriesLab

Whether you are an international scriptwriter, director or producer, you just need to be into the TV Series field.

Nine projects work on the creation of the concept: from generating ideas and structuring the material, up to a final pitch in front of major key players during an industry event when one of the projects receives a development grant.

SeriesLab Talents

This programme aims at scouting and training the best emerging drama writers coming from all over the world,

to create a hub of international writers equipped with the necessary tools to perform in a professional writers' room and to introduce them to the market. Over the months they will build strong connections and improve their work, quided by a high profiled script editor.

BOTH CALLS OPEN FROM 10TH JANUARY TO 1ST MARCH 2024

Red Sea Lodge

Open to teams of Saudi, Arab and African directors and producers (with writers if on board), working on a feature film project at any stage of development, Red Sea Lodge nurtures the next generation of filmmakers through script development sessions and a producer's coaching programme with the goal of giving voice to untold stories.

COMEDYLAB NEWEST ADDITION

ComedyLab is a truly unique concept that brings together passionate writers and talented comedians to create a fusion of expertise and comedic brilliance. It's an exclusive club targeting international scriptwriters or comedians with different backgrounds applying with or without a comedy feature film project. After a two-day preliminary workshop, up to 4 projects with the potential

for international success will be selected along with a group of writers and comedians without projects.

ComedyLab provides all of them with a tailored approach to script and production development.

Yes, it will be the first ever international Lab in Europe dedicated wholeheartedly to comedy.

CALL OPEN UNTIL 20TH DECEMBER 2023

GREEN FILM LAB

A whole programme fully focused on how to be kind to the planet while producing a film. Green Film Lab aims to create awareness about sustainability in the film industry. The workshop promotes environmentally sustainable practices in film production and guides film professionals through how to apply the Green Film rating system.

It features a series of 3-day workshops held in different European cities in collaboration with various film institutions and funds

Each workshop is open to film and series industry professionals, professionals with a background in sustainability and delegates from funds, film commissions or film institutions in general.

Green Film Lab is a programme by TorinoFilmLab and Green Film, organised by the National Museum of Cinema and Trentino Film Commission, in collaboration with EAVE.

Multiple workshops & multiple topics, across the year, dedicated to deepening various aspects from film development to audience design, just to mention a few. You can consider **TFL Next** a joyful long-distance relationship, a short but intense **online** version of our annual programmes, while **TFL Extended** is more of a romantic getaway, where you briefly meet with other film professionals, in person.

BOOST IT

TFL Italia happens in the frame of Torino Film Industry and has been created to connect Italian professionals with international productions and institutions. This year the initiative features the Boost IT Lab workshop: eight selected teams with a project take part in an exclusive plan of activities, including a final pitch in front of producers from all over the world on the 23rd of November in Torino

TFL FUNDS

Audience Design Fund

Distribution support addressed to European producers and sales agents working on internationally coproduced feature films selected to receive a grant of 45,000 € each plus customised sessions with TFL Audience Designers that lead the teams through the creation of innovative promotional strategies to reach the project's targets.

Co-Production Fund

Production support for international co-production of feature films (documentaries, fictions or animations, both from emerging and experienced filmmakers) involving European and non-European companies. **Two awards of 50,000 € each plus tailor-made consultancies** are allocated to producers based in a country participating in the Media sub-programme.

Besides, it is also a moment to **reward the best projects** with the TFL Production Awards, as well as partners' awards backing the further development, production and post-production.
