



TFL ANNUAL PROGRAMMES

SeriesLab

Whether you are an international scriptwriter, director or producer, you just need to be into the TV Series field. Bring your project and work on the creation of the concept: from generating ideas and structuring the material, up to a final pitch in front of major key players during a TV industry event. This programme looks for up to 9 drama series projects at an early development stage and for the first time TFL will assign a development grant of

€ 10.000 to one of them!

SeriesLab Talents

Second round for this programme that aims at scouting and training the best emerging drama writers coming from all over the world, to create a hub of international writers equipped with the necessary tools to perform in a professional writers' room, and to introduce them to the market. Guided by a high profiled script editor, they will experience the work in a real writers' room, building strong connections with other international writers.

Both programmes will be quite intertwined this year, giving a chance to the participants to network and exchange ideas. Especially because, they'll share the new Head of Studies, **Eszter Angyalosy**.

TFL ANNUAL PROGRAMMES

FeatureLab

When a film gets more and more real. This is the programme for creative teams working on the director's 1st or 2nd feature film projects, at an advanced development stage.

By joining you will have the chance to work with experts from the fields of directing, cinematography, sound, post-production, but also from production, financing, marketing & sales, and audience engagement. A big plus: FeatureLab projects will have the chance to compete for the TFL Production Awards and collateral prizes supporting the production process.

The call for applications for the current edition just expired! A new one will come later in the year.

ScriptLab

The flagship TFL screenwriting programme open to both emerging talents and experienced filmmakers that, quided by tutors, turn the projects into a first or second draft of the script sharing the creative process with fellow filmmakers. The call for application for the 2023 edition of ScriptLab is closed but a new call will pop up next Autumn.

Red Sea Lodge

Open to teams of Saudi. Arab and - from 2023 - African directors and producers (with writers if on board), working on a feature film project at any stage of development, Red Sea Lodge nurtures the next generation of filmmakers through script development sessions and a producer's coaching programme with the goal of giving voice to untold stories. This year's edition is ready to start, and it will end up during the Red Sea Film Festival in Jeddah.

ScriptLab Story Editing

Hands-on training that runs in parallel of ScriptLab involving film professionals who want to work with writers and directors in the scriptwriting process of their fiction feature film projects, developing an idea up to a professional draft of the script.

The promising auteurs and audiovisual professionals chosen to be in the TFL classes 2023 will be announced very soon, don't miss out!

- GREEN-FILM LAB

Green Film Lab keeps on promoting environmentally sustainable practices in audiovisual production and training audiovisual industry professionals on how to apply a green protocol and get a certification. Green Film Lab proposes 3-day workshops held in different European regions in collaboration with various film institutions and funds, in different moments of the year. It is open to film and TV series industry professionals willing to gain skills on green practices on set and make their projects sustainable, as well as sustainability managers interested in learning how to apply their expertise to the audiovisual context.

TFL FUNDS

Co-Production Fund

Production support for international co-production of feature films (both from emerging and experienced filmmakers) involving European and non-European production companies. Two awards of 50,000 € each plus tailor-made consultancies are allocated to producers based in a country participating in the Media sub-

programme, to bolster the realisation of the granted projects.

Audience Design Fund

Distribution support addressed to European producers and sales agents working on internationally co-produced feature films selected to receive a grant of 45,000 € each plus customised sessions with TFL Audience Designers that lead the teams through the creation of innovative promotional strategies to reach the project's targets.
