

TFL ANNUAL PROGRAMMES

FeatureLab

When a film gets more and more real. This is the programme for creative teams working on the director's 1st or 2nd feature film projects, at an advanced development stage. By joining you will have the chance to work with experts from the fields of directing, cinematography, sound, postproduction, but also from production, financing, marketing & sales, and audience engagement. A big plus: FeatureLab projects will have the chance to compete for the TFL Production Awards and collateral prizes supporting the production process.

SeriesLab

Whether you are a scriptwriter, director or producer, you just need to be into the TV Series field. This programme looks for fiction TV series projects at an early development stage. Bring your project and work on the creation of the concept. from generating ideas and structuring the material, up to a final pitch in front of major key players during a TV industry event.

SeriesLab Talents

Brand-new programme that aims at scouting and training the best emerging talents in new drama writing, to give them the chance to experience the work in a real writers' room, guided by a high profiled script editor, and to build strong connections with other international writers.

ScriptLab

The flagship TFL screenwriting programme open to both emerging talents and experienced filmmakers

that, guided by tutors, turn the projects into a first or second draft of the script sharing the creative process with fellow filmmakers. Each group is paired with a Story Editor trainee that will work in close collaboration with the filmmakers to help them find the core of their story. The call for application for the 2023 edition of ScriptLab is closed but a new call will pop up next Autumn.

Red Sea Lodge

It nurtures the next generation of filmmakers from Saudi and the Arab

world through script development sessions and a producer's coaching programme with the goal of giving voice to untold stories. It comes to an end during the Red Sea Film Festival in Jeddah.

Multiple workshops & multiple topics, across the year, dedicated to deepening various aspects from film development to audience design, just to mention a few. You can consider TFL Next a joyful longdistance relationship, a short but intense **online** version of our annual programmes, while TFL Extended is more of a romantic getaway, where you briefly meet with other film professionals, **in person**. You may have to wait a little longer for the full list of workshops 2023, in the meantime take the chance to get insights and tools to create concrete audience engagement strategies for feature film projects. Apply to **TFL Extended - Audience Design**, taking place next February in the frame of European Film Market (Berlin).

Audience Design Fund

Distribution support addressed to European producers and sales agents working on internationally co-produced feature films selected to receive a grant of $45,000 \in$ each plus customised sessions with TFL Audience Designers that lead the teams through the creation of innovative promotional strategies to reach the project's targets.

Co-Production Fund

Production support for international co-production of feature films involving European and non-European production companies. Tailor-made consultancies and an award of 50,000 € are allocated to a producer based in a country participating in the Media subprogramme, to bolster the realisation of the project.

NEXT CALL OPEN FROM 23rd JANUARY TO 30th MARCH 2023 Big piece of news of this year, a whole programme fully focused on how to be kind with the planet while producing a film. Green Film Lab promotes **environmentally sustainable practices in audiovisual production** by training professionals through a number of 3-day workshops held in different European cities in collaboration with various film institutions and funds. Each workshop is open to **creative teams** working on a project, **production professionals** and **sustainability managers**.

Green Film Lab IRELAND, March 2023 - Dublin CALL OPEN FROM 28th NOVEMBER 2022 TO 20th JANUARY 2023 Green Film Lab is a programme by TorinoFilmLab and Green Film, organised by Museo Nazionale del Cinema and Trentino Film Commission, in collaboration with EAVE.



A fresh TFL section that puts together **TorinoFilmLab's programmes with a special eye on Italian audiovisual sector**. TFL Italia matches the national film industry with foreign bodies interested in cooperating across the borders and, through high-level training, aims at the internationalisation of the Italian film professionals. The actual debut happens on 24th November in frame of TFI Torino Film Industry and features two TFL programmes:

Alpi Film Lab

Our Italian-French training programme that brings together emerging producers and directors from both sides to

experience a simulation of transregional co-production while developing feature film projects. Realised with Annecy Cinéma Italien/Bontieu Scène nationale Annecy and financed by Interreg Italia-Francia ALCOTRA 2014-2020 - European Regional Development Fund, the initiative's ultimate goal is to enhance the crossborder film industry, strengthening its competitiveness on the international market.

Up & Coming Italia

Through a brief but concentrated 2-day workshop it guides **6 emerging Italian producers**, in team with directors, moving their first steps into international co-production. It provides a new generation of professionals with tools and guidance to work internationally.

TFL STANDS WITH TorinoFilmLab
